

Hi Flames, Lasers, Comet and Bolt!

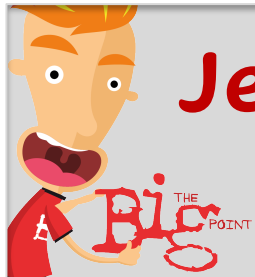


Today we remember **GOOD FRIDAY** when **JESUS** gave his life for us so we could know God as our friend and **KING**. What love!

IF YOU LIKE A BIT OF SCIENCE, HERE IS AN EXPERIMENT YOU CAN DO WITH A GROWN UP THAT SHOWS HOW JESUS TOOK OUR SIN

You will need:

a plate, a coin, a candle, matches, a cup of (any) coloured water and a clear glass.

Instructions:

(Grown-up) Put the plate in front of you. Hold up the coin and explain that it represents us (place it on the plate, towards the side). The coloured water represents our sin (pour it over the coin to submerge it). What do you think the candle represents? The candle represents Jesus (place the candle on the plate in the water). GROWN UP: Light the candle carefully. What do you think the flame represents? The flame represents Jesus, the Light of the world. Watch carefully as you take the glass and put it over the lighted candle. Within a few seconds, the flame will consume all the oxygen in the glass and be extinguished. However, it will have created a vacuum, which in turn will draw the water up inside the glass (thus surrounding the candle) and leave the coin dry.

On the cross Jesus gave up his life (the flame went out) so that he could take our sins on Himself and we could be free!
