This week in our bible story a man called Elijah discovers that God is with him in all the good times and the bad. He is with you too and He loves you so VERY much!



2. Whisper, whisper

God spoke to Elijah in a whisper. Whisper an instruction to your child. They must do what you say to them. They must listen carefully to do it correctly. Allow them to whisper an instruction to you or other children. Not too loud or to auiet!

Or (if there are enough of you) you could play the traditional game of Chinese whispers. Talk about listening to God.

1. Elijah prayed and the rain came. Can you make a rain bottle?

Find a bottle or jar and a lid. Fill the bottle almost all the way with water and then add a couple of teaspoons of glitter. Screw the lid on tightly (you might want to use some glue or tape to be on the safe side).

Make and decorate a label that says Heros rely on God'. Shake the bottle and the glitter will swirl around like rain then gradually fall to the bottle of the bottle. Use it to help you pray.
