SOME EXTRA IDEAS FOR SPARKS

Dressing up ...who do you like to dress up as?

Put on your favourite costume and pretend to be that character 😊
Jesus wants us to be like him but we can't do that by dressing up in a costume! Or by pretending!
We can grow to BE LIKE HIM by spending time praying and reading our bibles and asking Him to help us by filling us with the Holy Spirit.

While dressed in your fave costume, choose a bible story to read with your grown-up.
Talk to Jesus and ask Him to make you more like Him.

WALKING ON WATER!
Read the story when Peter walked on water. Have some fun testing objects to see if they float or sink.
Talk together about how Jesus helped Peter to grow in faith.

Simon says
Play the traditional game where the leader gives a command and others only copy if it is preceded by the phrase 'Simon says'. Try and catch each other out!
Grown-ups, talk with your Sparks about how followers of Jesus want to do what Jesus says - to love God and love others.
