MAKE A CROSS

1: Lay a sheet of paper vertically in front of you. Then fold the top left comer of the page across to the other side.


2: Fold the right top corner down.

3: Fold in half along the vertical line.

4: Fold in half vertically again,

5: Then take short edge across, folding in half vertically a third time.

6: Lastly, take a pair of saissors and cut one long cut all the way up the vertical line. Then open the folds to show a cross shape!



The 4 Points

- 1. God loves me
- 2. I have sinned
- 3. Jesus died for me
- 4. I need to decide to live for God
